

From a letter transcribed by Wayne Morrison

*Glenelg June 18<sup>th</sup> 1802*

*The bearer Malcom McCuaig 50 and his wife Janet McDonald age 45 and his sister Mary McCuaig age 52 emigrated to Canada North America with their children:*
